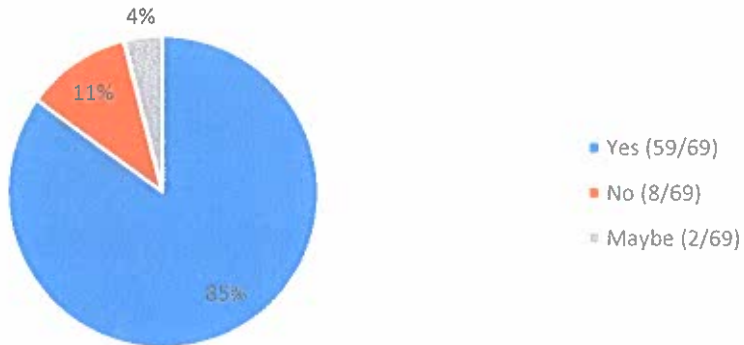

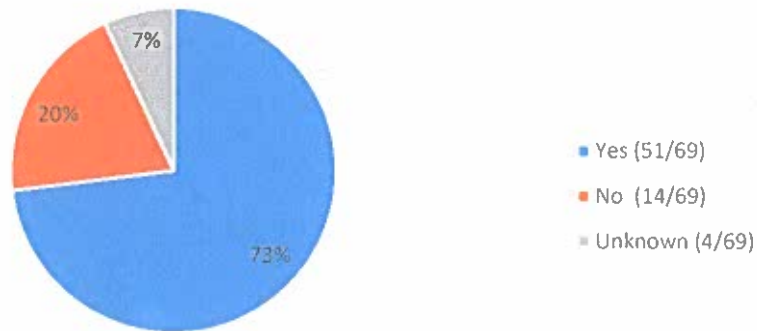
Would you support indoor visits in residents rooms with safe measures in place?

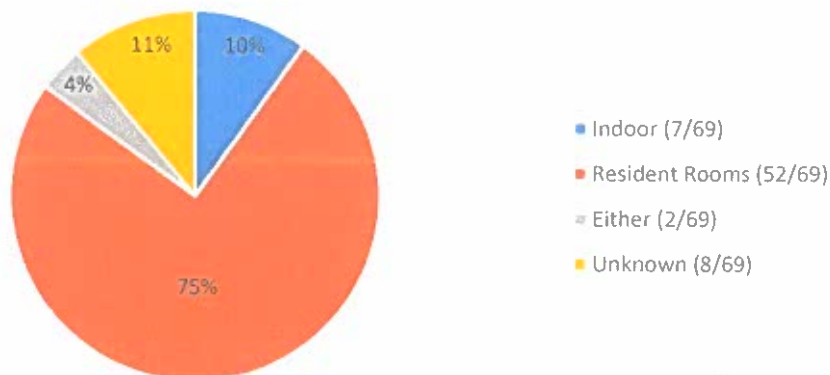

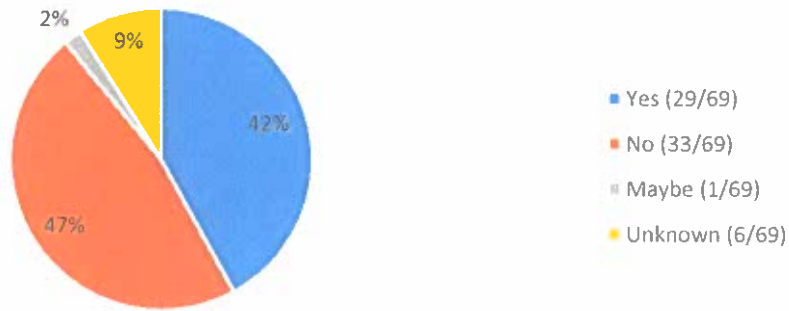
What type of inside visit would you have greater support for?

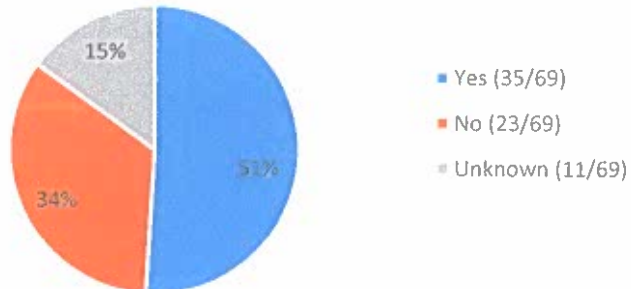

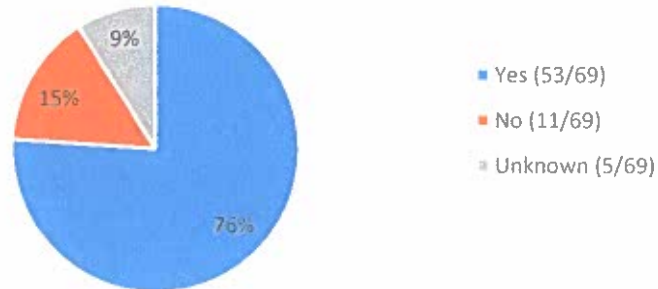
Are there any additional safety measures you would like to see in place for inside or outside visits?

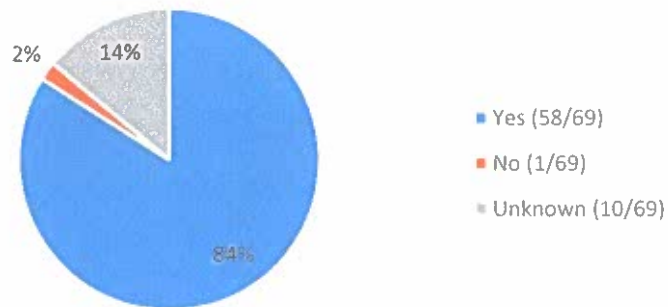

August 2020

1. Would you support the Hythe Pioneer Home opening a designated shared indoor space for visitors, with safe measures in place, to accommodate for visitors?

➤ **NO**

- Not until December
- There could be more than one family at a time
- Too many people still have Covid in the community
- We've been so fortunate all this time and especially during the summer. What's the big hardship being outside when visiting?
- Greater work load for staff as a deep clean/sanitization would be necessary after each visit
- It is too soon, they can bring in the virus
- Too hard to trace if the flu came

➤ **UNKNOWN**

- Not against it, but doesn't like the idea of it being in a big space (chapel, etc.), it would be too hard to clean and would still have to book

➤ **YES**

- A few at a time for ½ hour or so
- Lots of cleaning must be maintained between visiting families
- Only if it was raining, when it snows it will be a whole new thing to do
- It does not matter to me either way, leave outside visits for summer and inside visits for winter

➤ **NO**

- We have no idea where the person has been, they might have just been to the store for groceries but, look at all the people they've been around
- My room is too hot

➤ **YES**
